



**Puppy I (Puppy Kindergarten)** - You will not find a better puppy class anywhere! We offer a comprehensive and well-rounded class for young pups (up to 5 months) that covers everything to give them a great start on their adventure called life.



**Puppy II (AKC's S.T.A.R.Puppy)** - You must attend Puppy I to enroll, and your pup must still be under the age of one. Puppy II is geared toward earning the S.T.A.R.Puppy award from the American Kennel Club. A proud achievement indeed! You've already laid the foundation in Puppy I to prepare for the S.T.A.R. puppy test that is given at the end of the course. \*\*Puppy I & Puppy II classes usually occur at the same time (depending on class size). Puppy II is basically more review and skills practice from Puppy I, with an emphasis on earning the AKC award. Puppy II meets for 2 classes.



**Tweens & Teens** - For dogs from 5 to 18 months of age who missed the cut off for our Kindergarten class or for those who are not interested in the AKC award but still want to build a great foundation of manners through positive learning and experiences. We help you get through those trying adolescent times, learning what is to be expected, how to deal with behavior issues that come and go and to build those manners every dog must have.



**Trick Dog** - Have a blast with your dog learning various behaviors and tricks that can be used a variety of ways: as tools when distractions are needed, mental and physical stimulation,, bond building, pure fun! There are 5 levels in the program for your dog to earn titles (Novice, Intermediate, Advanced, Expert, Champion).



**Canine Good Citizen** - Can your dog anywhere confident he will represent the best of canine manners? Would you like to earn an official title for your dog? This class fine-tunes skills all dogs should have and prepares the dog/handler team for the Canine Good Citizen award and title test. This is a proud accomplishment indeed! Your dog must already have had basic manners training and be social towards people and other dogs.



**Rally** - (also known as Rally-O or Rally Obedience) is a sport in which the dog and handler move through a course of stations. Each of these stations has a sign providing instructions regarding the next skill that is to be performed. The team stops at each sign and completes the skill before moving on. The team proceeds at their own pace.



**Canine Freestyle Dance** - Would you and your dog enjoy a really fun time? Do you need a little change of pace in your training routine? Is your dog ready for a new challenge? You and your dog perform simple tricks together that makes you look like you've been dancing together for years!



**Fun & Games** - What a fun-tastic way to have a blast with your dog, meet other dog-lovers, play games and maybe win some prizes! Show off your doggie's tricks, play musical chairs, bob for tennis balls, try your paw at the muffin tin game and many more fun activities!

Any and all levels of training are welcome. You'd be surprised who wins!



**K9 Conditioning** - Your dog will build confidence, balance, strength and body awareness all while engaging him or her mentally and physically. This class helps dogs overcome challenges and flourish as they learn to execute physical exercises as well as to focus and actively problem-solve. Great for athletes, puppies, over-weight dogs and those who are incredibly active and need an outlet for all that energy! It's an awesome activity/class for any dog really! Safety is our top priority and we utilize special equipment to work your dog on various exercises.



**Therapy Dog Prep** - Do you have a social butterfly that loves everyone and everything? Have you thought about putting those special skills to use to bring joy and comfort to those who could benefit? Therapy Dogs are specially trained to utilize their natural calm temperaments and manners in environments that are not so natural. Our prep course teaches you and your dog how to prepare for and deal with these things confidently so they can provide a much needed and much appreciated service. Your dog must already have had basic manners training and be social towards people.



**Funtime Agility** - Heard of the sport, but not sure where to begin? Come learn what the craze is all about! Our spacious indoor training area with non-slip flooring provides the perfect medium for introducing you and your dog to practice Agility in a relaxed, fun and un-intimidating atmosphere. Two levels available: Beginners & Advanced.



**Obedience/Manners** - Does your dog jump, pull at the end of the leash, have trouble listening, won't come or stay on command? You need our Basic Manners class! For those who have laid the foundation skills, continue on to Advanced Manners. Advanced Manners is also good for those who like to keep in practice and for those who are simply rusty and need to fine-tune their skills.



**Reactive Dog** - If you are uncomfortable or embarrassed to take your dog to a "regular" obedience class because of barking and/or lunging at other dogs, among other things, this class may be for you. Our classes take place in a supportive, safe and controlled environment under the careful guidance of several experienced trainers present during each session. We give you the skills and techniques to help identify your dog's triggers, and re-focus and re-condition your dog in a positive manner.



**Out and About** - A 4 week course aimed at perfecting your dog's good citizenship. The class starts in-house with 2 weeks to brush up on basic manners and skills, while gradually increasing distractions, stimuli and training environments. The next 2 weeks involve field trips to real-world training opportunity scenarios. We'll meet at a different location each week and put those well-practiced behaviors to the test! This class is for dogs that are socially sound and comfortable near people and other dogs. This is also an excellent course for those interested in earning their CGC, CGCA and CGCU titles.



**Scent Work** - Does your pooch have a constantly patrolling snoz? Does his nose know all the best places to search for smells? Put that amazing sniffer to work seeking scents in a structured manner. Dogs absolutely LOVE this class as it utilizes their natural skills. Any age can participate.



**Focus Work** - This class is for: \*those who you have an "impossible" dog that's more interested in his own agenda and could care less if he does something his or her owner asks. \*For experienced teams that work great together, this class can take you to the next level! \*For handlers that have hit a training snag and are just looking for some "fresh" ideas for how to work with, and interact with your dog.
